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# Future Leaders Development Program

## Program Overview

This program was established in an effort to provide Hockey Alberta with a platform to develop and train individuals in hockey to be effective on ice instructors and leaders within Alberta. This will be the 8th consecutive Future Leaders Development Program with a theme of "Making it Real!" It will be held May 14-16, 2010 in Leduc, AB.

Selected future leaders will be trained and mentored on and off ice through classroom sessions that include: designing skills within drills, communication, being a leader, building self and team building.

At the completion of the program all future leaders will be accredited in the NCCP Coach Level and Speak Out program.

## Eligibility Criteria

1. Interested in teaching/ coaching the game.
2. Attending a post secondary institution.
3. Endorsed by club team or professor.

## Preference Criteria

1. Majoring in Ed. or Phys.Ed.
2. Currently active in coaching LMHA team.
3. Playing or has played Junior varsity College or University Hockey.
4. Graduating and willing to move into an instructor/ coaching role within Hockey Alberta.

## Program Costs

There will be no cost to selected Future Leaders; however, they will be responsible for instructing and assisting in at least two (2) Hockey Alberta or LMHA clinics, skills camps or jamborees during the 2010-11 hockey season.

## Application Process

Complete the application form on the back of this pamphlet and submit to Hockey Alberta by April 5, 2010.

Application must include:

1. Resume
2. Reference Letter
3. Education Background
4. Playing Experiences
5. Post Secondary Education Registration Information
6. Applicable Leadership Experience

## Leader Expectations

- Design and implement on and off-ice skill sessions.
- Coordinate and lead players throughout the weekend.
- Lead and support HA staff during off and on-ice sessions.
- Team Build with their assigned group.
- Help athletes achieve a comfort level with each other on and off the ice.
- Ensure all athletes under their charge exhibit the principles of fair play, discipline, respect and safety at all times.
- Ensure the development of self-esteem in all athletes.
- Support the team and be a team player.
- Be in good standing of Hockey Alberta.
- Respect each other and the FLDP.

## Scholarship Program

Up to eight (8) scholarships will be awarded. The eight candidates who are invited to and complete the requirements at the Team Alberta Provincial Camps in July 2010 will be eligible for the Hockey Alberta Foundation Award of Excellence in Leadership scholarship. Full scholarships will be awarded upon completion of the Spring, Summer and Fall F.L.D.P. requirements.

Scholarships are only available to those students who are:

- Current or incoming to a Post Secondary Institute.
- Pursuing a leadership position in hockey as an instructor or volunteer.
- Albertan or out of province students with at least 2 yrs residency/ attendance at a Post Secondary Institute prior to the application date.
- Has a minimum GPA of 2.0, enrolled in a minimum of three (3) courses per semester and recognized as a fulltime student.
