

OPERATIONAL POLICY: MEMBERSHIP AWARDS

DATE ISSUED: May 1, 2018 LAST UPDATED: May 1, 2020

Policy: To annually recognize those persons who have made an outstanding contribution to amateur hockey. Hockey Alberta members, volunteers and/or staff shall have the ability to nominate candidates in various categories. Hockey Alberta will review all nominations and present awards to those deemed to have made the most significant impact.

Eligibility: Seven (7) categories of awards are 'PUBLIC' and open to nominations from Hockey Alberta Member organizations, sanctioned Leagues, sanctioned Junior/ Senior Club Teams, Hockey Alberta Volunteers or Staff Members. Three (3) categories of awards are 'INTERNAL' and will be determined by Hockey Alberta through a review of all eligible candidates are not open to nominations. The Awards and subsequent categories are:

PUBLIC NOMINATION

- Volunteer of the Year
- Coach of the Year
- Player of the Year
- Official of the Year
- Team of the Year
- MHA of the Year
- Order of Merit

INTERNAL REVIEW

- Zone Award
- Provincial Championships Host Site
- Lifetime Achievement Award

Recognition Procedures: Hockey Alberta will determine the appropriate method for presenting each award on an annual basis. Successful nominees will be notified about their selection and invited to attend a presentation event to be recognized and to receive the award.

In case of a banquet/ formal awards ceremony, individual Award Recipients will be offered accreditation for themselves and one (1) guest as well as the necessary accommodations (if applicable). Group / Team Award Recipients will be offered accreditation for twenty-five (25) people as well as a preferred rate for group hotel room bookings (if applicable). Additional accreditation for the banquet/ ceremony can be requested of Hockey Alberta at the recipient's expense.
